MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
May 29, 1984

All Board Members were present

Opinions and Orders were adopted in the following cases by a vote of 6-0: ##82-111, Modine; 83-77, Tuscola, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 83-104, Cupp, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 83-164, West Dundee; 82-2, Crystal Lake; 84-31, Kerr-McGee.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #84-24, Department of the Air Force, by a vote of 5-1. Mr. Dumelle dissented.

Motion to correct Order in #83-105, Ford Motor, was granted by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for decision in #84-26, OMC, was granted by a vote of 6-0.

Hearing was authorized in #84-33, Commonwealth Edison.

Motion to dismiss was granted in #82-151, Phillips Pipeline, by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In new regulatory matters these actions were taken by a vote of 6-0: R84-18, Rock Island, Site Specific, authorized for hearing and publication and 200 signature requirement waived; R84-, Insta-Foam, Petition to Delist, held to June 14 for consideration; R84-19, Carus Chemical, Algicide Amendments, authorized for hearing and publication and consolidated with R84-4; R84-20, City of Joliet (Eastside Joliet), authorized for hearing and publication.

A revision to the FY 84 regular meeting schedule was adopted and the Board approved a meeting schedule for FY 85 which will be announced in the Board's Environmental Register.
