A Final Rule, Opinion and Order was adopted in R84-34, Dioxin Hazardous Waste Listing, by a vote of 5-0.
A Proposed Rule, Second Notice Opinion was adopted in R83-28B, Definition of Liquid Hazardous Waste, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Forcade concurred.
