FEBRUARY 25, 1993 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS**

All Board Members were present save M. Nardulli who is ill.

A Final Opinion and Order was adopted in #90-146, Village of Matteson, by a vote of 6-0. J. Theodore Meyer concurred. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #90-170, Goose Lake Association, by a vote of 6-0. (JA)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #91-183, Thomas and Barbara Sneed, by a vote of 5-1. B. Forcade dissented. (JTM)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AC 92-33 (Docket A & B), James Alexander, by a vote of 6-0. (JA)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #92-156, County Board of Whiteside, by a vote of 5-0. J. Theodore Meyer abstained. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #92-173, Illico Independent Oil Company, by a vote of 6-0. (JTM)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in ##92-174, - 177, Alice Zeman, by a vote of 6-0. Messrs. G. Tanner Girard and J. Theodore Meyer concurred. (JA)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #92-23, City of Chester, by a vote of 4-2. Messrs. B. Forcade and J. Theodore Meyer dissented. (JA)

Motion to reconsider the Opinion and Order adopted previously in #92-156, County of Whiteside, by B. Forcade and seconded by R.C. Flemal carried by a vote of 5-1, with J. Theodore Meyer dissenting. Motion to amend the earlier Opinion and Order by B. Forcade and seconded by R.C. Flemal carried by a vote of 5-1, with J. Theodore Meyer dissenting.
