MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING OCTOBER 7, 1993 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning introduced and welcomed John Cross, who will serve as the Legislative Liaison to the Board. All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AS 92-7, Illinois Power Company, by a vote of 7-0. J. Anderson, J. Theodore Meyer, and M. Nardulli concurred. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AS 92-14, Quantum Chemical Corporation, by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #93-114, Browning-Ferris Industries and Ogle County Board, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #91-173, Marathon Oil Company (Appellate Court Remand), by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)

In R91-23, Marathon Oil Company Site-Specific, a Proposed Rule, First Notice, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)

In R93-11, Smaller Source Permit Rules, a Proposed Rule, Second Notice, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)
