Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
January 8, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:

An Opinion an Order was adopted in #80-153, Hamman, by a vote
of 4-1, Mr. Goodman dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-166, Staunton, by a vote
of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

Motion to dismiss was granted in #77-212, Bloomingdale.

A Hearing Officer Order was affirmed in #79-61, Illinois Power
by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Werner dissented, Mr. Goodman will prepare
an Order.

Pursuant to request of petitioner, a hearing was authorized in
#79-134, Commonwealth Edison, Rule 410(c) determination.

The Board discussed the Order of procedure for the hearing in
#80-184, Akron Land. It was agreed that no Order would be en-
tered and that if necessary Mr. Goodman would confer with the Hearing
Officer on procedure only.

Motion for extension of time to file an amended petition was granted
in #80-204, Decatur, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare
an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-218, Mercy Hospital acknowledging
objections filed and authorizing hearings in the counties in which
the objectors reside. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare
an Order.

Motion to Strike was denied in #80-220, Schaumburg, by a vote of
5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #79-78, Quincy, by a vote
of 4-0, Dr. Satchell abstained.
