MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
March 5, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: #77-339, Cary; 78-263, East Peoria; 78-313, Citizens Utilities (Mr. Dumelle concurred); 79-41, Geiss (Mrs. Anderson concurred); 80-196, Illinois Power; 80-207, Travenol Labs; 80-208, Trivoli; 80-221, Hanover Park.

A Final Opinion and Order was adopted in R79-3, "CAP", which dismissed the proceeding by a vote of 5-0.

R76-19, Noise Amendments to Rules 205 and 209, was adopted as a Final Order by a vote of 5-0.

Motion for reconsideration was granted in #77-167, Paxton, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

A Supplemental Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-206, Hanna City, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Opinion and Order.

Motion for extension of time to file an amended petition in #80-224, Beker, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #81-10, LaSalle, pursuant to a motion in limine and a motion to strike. The vote was 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare the Order.

Motion to amend and motion to compel joinder were granted in #81-15, Marquette, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

Motions for extension of time to file the records in ##81-23, -24, Alburn, were granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

#81-25, Kearney, was construed as a request for clarification. An Order was adopted by a vote of 5-0 which will be prepared by Mr. Dumelle.


Minutes as corrected were approved by a vote of 5-0 for meetings held December 18 and 19, and 24, 1980 and January 8, 1981.
