The matter was reassigned to Mr. Dumelle and a vote taken again. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Werner concurred.

Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted in R80-9,-10, Blasting Noise, by a vote of 5-0.

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R80-19, Hazardous Hospital Wastes, by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Werner concurred.

Motion for extension of time was granted in #81-4, Knoxville, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.
