July 23, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

Proposed Rule, First Notice was adopted in R80-11, Ozone, by a

Proposed Rule, First Notice was adopted in R81-16, Interim Rules,  
Nonattainment Permit Program, by a vote of 5-0.

R76-21, WQS Effluent Revision was ordered held for possible meeting
