All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-62, Bravo-Ernst by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Werner abstained.

The Board issued an Order regarding a discovery schedule in ##79-26, -167, Continental Grain, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

A Final Opinion and Order was adopted in #79-256, ESL, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner Concurred.

Motion for stay in #79-266, U.S. Steel, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An extension of time was granted in #81-54, Drake, for the respondents to file a reply to a motion for reconsideration. The vote was 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to strike in #81-155, Bledsoe, denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file an amended petition was granted in #81-163, Deere, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

81-165, John Prior and 81-167, ZYX Dixon were dismissed by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Orders.

Village of Milan was ordered joined as a party in #81-148, Oak Grove, and the matter was held for an Agency recommendation. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
