MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
December 17, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Werner who was ill. Mr. Goodman presented the Opinions and Orders assigned to Mr. Werner.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 79-239, Herrin; 80-185, Piolet Bros., Mr. Anderson concurred; 81-124, Dow Chemical.

Final Opinions and Orders, Adopted Rules, were adopted in R77-15, Sulfur Dioxide and R81-16, Non-Attainment Interim Permits. The votes were 4-0.

An Order was adopted in #78-62, Davenport, on a motion for clarification. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motions for continuances were granted in ##80-232,-233, Wastex, by votes of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Orders.

Motion for reconsideration was denied in #81-54, Drake & Brady, by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Petition for reconsideration was denied in #81-105, Technical Services, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #81-119, Mendota, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-123, Ferrill v. Donovan, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for expedited consideration filed by CPC in R77-15, Sulfur Dioxide, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
