After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning asked the Clerk for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except Messrs. Girard, Flemal and Meyer, who were absent.

A Default Order was adopted in this Administrative Citation by a vote of 4-0: #95-14, IEPA v. Ken Lomax and Ken Lomax Enterprises.

An Order granting the Respondent's motion to withdraw its petition for review, and unless the penalty has already been paid, directing the Respondent to pay, within 30 days of the date of the Order, a penalty in the amount of 500.00, was adopted in #AC 94-100, County of Macon v. Macon County Landfill, by a vote of 4-0. (JY)

An Order granting the Respondent's motion for a non-resident attorney to appear on its behalf, was adopted in #AC 95-11, IEPA v. Gordon McCann and the Larson Foundation, by a vote of 4-0.

An Order granting the Complainant's motion to dismiss the administrative citation, was adopted in #AC 95-17, Sangamon County v. The Illinois National Bank of Springfield, n/k/a First America Trust Company, as Trustee under the provisions of a Trust Agreement dated January 19, 1990, and knowN as Trust Number 894-6418-002, and Ray Landers, by a vote of 4-0. An Order accepting the matter for hearing was adopted in #95-102, Shell Oil Company v. IEPA, by a vote of 4-0.




