MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 18, 1996 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Board Member J. Theodore Meyer welcomed the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except Chairman C. Manning, who was in Springfield due to other Board related business, and Board Member M. McFawn, who was out of town speaking at a national seminar on behalf of the Board.

Minutes of the April 4, 1996 Minutes were approved by a vote of 5-0.

In R95-17, Safe Drinking Water Act Update, USEPA Amendments (January 1 through June 30, 1995), a Proposal for Public Comment, Proposed Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 5-0. (RCF)

In R96-12, Pretreatment Update, USEPA Regulations (July 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995), a Proposal for Public Comment, Proposed Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 5-0. (ED)

An Order accepting the joint status report in response to a January 18, 1996 Board Order, granting the motion for extension of stay until July 10, 1996, and directing the parties to file status reports, either jointly or separately, no later than July 10, 1996, was adopted in #AS 94-5, Petition of Abbott Laboratories for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 218 Subpart RR, by a vote of 5-0. (JTM)

No action was taken by the Board on an amended petition filed in response to a February 15, 1996 Board Order in #AS 96-7, Petition of the City of Belleville, Illinois for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 306.305(b).

An Order accepting the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement in the amount of \$18,000.00, was adopted in #95-175, People of the State of Illinois v. Polymer Color, Inc., by a vote of 5-0. (JTM)

A Default Order finding that the respondent violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and assessing a \$500.00 penalty, was adopted in #AC 96-39, IEPA v. M.K. O'Hara Construction, Inc., Kenneth O'Hara and Madalyn O'Hara, by a vote of 5-0.

An Order closing the docket since the Perry County Board of Commissioners accepted the withdrawal of the Petitioner's siting application, was adopted in #92-131, C.O.A.L. (Citizens Opposed to Additional Landfills) v. Laidlaw Waste Systems, Inc., Perry County Board of Commissioners, by a vote of 5-0. (GTG)

An Order granting the respondent's motion for an extension of time until June 10, 1996 to file its brief, was adopted in #94-146, Dorothy L. Hoffman v. City of Columbia, Illinois, by a vote of 5-0. (JY)

An Order directing the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice of a motion for relief from hearing requirement, was adopted in #95-106, People of the State of Illinois v. Claude F. Perry and Martha Perry, by a vote of 5-0. (RCF)

An Order granting the petitioner's voluntary motion to dismiss its petition for variance, was adopted in #95-161, S&C Electric Company v. IEPA, by a vote of 5-0. JY

IEPA, by a vote of 5-0. (GTG)

An Order granting the Agency's motion for an extension of time until May 11, 1996 in which to file the Agency recommendation, was adopted in #96-193, W.R. Grace & Company-Connecticut v. IEPA, by a vote of 5-0. (JTM)

An Order directing the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice of a motion to request relief from hearing requirement, was adopted in #96-211, People of the State of Illinois v. Classic Mold Company, Inc., and Larry Caldrone, by a vote of 5-0.

An Order directing the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice of a motion to request relief from hearing requirement, was adopted in #96-212, People of the State of Illinois v. Egyptian Community School District Unit #5, by a vote of 5-0.

An Order granting the respondent's motion for an extension of time until June 14, 1996 in which to file an answer to the complaint, was adopted in #96-186, Mr. & Mrs. Don Williams, Mr. & Mrs. Thomas Morris & Mr. and Mrs. Peter Bizios v. Schaumburg Park District, by a vote of 5-0. (ED)

A mandatory hearing will be held in #96-214, People of the State of Illinois v. Brass Foundry Company, Inc..

An Order accepting the matter for hearing, was adopted in #96-215, Illinois State Toll Highway Authority v. IEPA, by a vote of 5-0. (GTG)

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before June 9, 1996, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #96-216, Richard Johnson v. IEPA, by a vote of 5-0. (GTG)

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before June 6, 1996, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner

that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #96-217, Jewel Food Stores, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 5-0. (GTG)




