MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING MAY 2, 1996 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except J. Theodore Meyer who was absent.

Minutes of the April 18, 1996 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 4-0. Chairman C. Manning and Board Member M. McFawn abstained.

Adm. Code 302.202, 302.212, 302.213, 304.122 and 304.301(Ammonia Nitrogen), by a vote of 6-0. (ED)(CAM)(RCF)

In #AS 96-1, Petition of Illinois Power Company (Baldwin Power Plant) for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.208 and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.105 (Boron), an Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 5-0. Board Member M. McFawn abstained. (RCF)


