### MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING AUGUST 15, 1996 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff, her daughter Katie, and Katie's friend, Gina Shurig, to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except for Board Member J. Theodore Meyer, who was on vacation.

Minutes of the August 1, 1996 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 4-0. Board Members R.C. Flemal and M. McFawn abstained.

In R96-1, Proposed Alternative Standards for Coal Combustion Power Generating Facilities Waste Landfills; 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 816, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 6-0. **(JY)**

In R96-3, Steel and Foundry Industry Waste Landfills: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 817.309 (Facility Location for Landfills Accepting Potentially Usable Waste), a Proposed Rule, First Notice, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 6-0. **(RCF)**

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AS 96-9, Petition of Commonwealth Edison Company for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.814, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member M. McFawn concurred. **(RCF)**

An Order granting the Agency's motion for leave to file response instanter, was adopted in #AS 96-10, Petition of Commonwealth Edison Company for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.211(d) and (e), by a vote of 6-0. **(ED)**

An Order directing the hearing officer to contact the parties to determine if they wish to proceed to hearing so that the stipulation and proposed settlement agreement, filed with the Board August 1, 1996, may be entered into a Board order, and directing the complainant to file a motion to withdraw the complaint if the parties do not wish to go to hearing, was adopted in #96-69, Thomas Corning and Kimberly Corning v. Thurela's, Pam Hegji and Arthur Hegji as Owners, by a vote of 6-0. **(JY)**

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #96-182, A.F. Moore & Associates v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. **(McF)**

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #96-218, Mobil Oil Corporation (Joliet Refinery) v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. **(ED)**

An Opinion and Order granting the parties' joint motion for waiver of hearing requirement, and accepting the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement Agreement in the amount of \$8,500.00,

was adopted in #96-257, People of the State of Illinois v. Rockford Blacktop Construction Company, by a vote of 6-0. **(CAM)**

An Opinion and Order granting the parties' joint motion for waiver of hearing requirement, and accepting the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement Agreements in the amount of \$1,500.00, to be submitted by respondent, Atlas Dismantling Corporation, and \$5,200.00 to be submitted by respondent, Cary Corners Partnership, was adopted in #96-267, People of the State of Illinois v. An Agency motion to modify proposed compliance plan and certification of Agency Recommendation Instantier filed in PCB 96-239, The Solar Corporation v. IEPA, will be taken with the case-in-chief.

An Order directing the complainant to file proof of service or an appropriate motion on or before September 1, 1996 or the matter will be subject to dismissal, was adopted in #96-265, Edward M. Pearl v. Bicoastal Corporation, Singer Corporation, Controls Corporation of America Employee Profit Sharing and Retirement Trust, and Eaton Corporation, by a vote of 6-0. **(JY)**

An Order directing the complainants to file proof of service or an appropriate motion on or before September 1, 1996 or the matter will be subject to dismissal, was adopted in #96-266, J. Clarke Baker & Company and Real Estate Fund, Inc. v. Brunswick Corporation, L & J Engineering, Inc., GPE Controls, Inc., and Vapor Corporation, by a vote of 6-0. **(McF)**

An Order requesting additional information within 45 days of the date of the order, was adopted in #97-21, DeKalb Sanitary District v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. **(GTG)**

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before October 1, 1996, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #97-25, Grimm's Pharmacy v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. **(CAM)**

A mandatory hearing will be held in #97-26, People of the State of Illinois v. Central Illinois Public Service Company.


A provisional variance was granted in #97-32, Village of Ashland v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. **(CAM)**

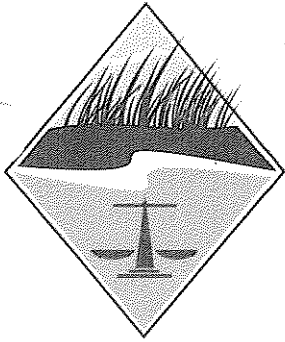
All other matters not disposed of as listed were held.

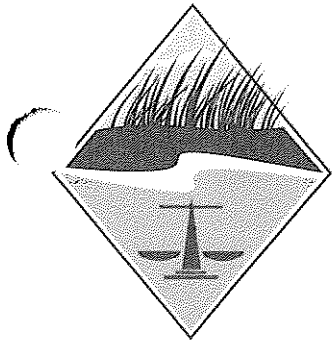

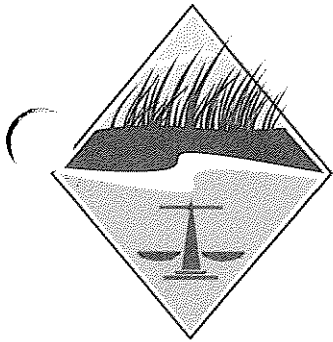
