## MINUTES OF SPECIAL BOARD MEETING AUGUST 26, 1991 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

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Pursuant to notice given, the meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #90-102, State Oil Company, by a vote of 6-1. J. Dumelle dissented. (JTM)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #91-7, Land and Lakes, by a vote of 6-1. J. Dumelle dissented and R.C. Flemal concurred. (JA)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #91-72, Clean Quality Resources, by a vote of 7-0. J. Dumelle concurred. (MN)

An Order dismissing the proceedings, effective in 45 days with public comments accepted in the interim, was adopted in R88-8, Census of Section 21(d) Facilities, by a vote of 7-0. (JA)

A Proposed Rule, First Notice, Opinion and Order was adopted in R91-22,  $PM_{10}$  Emission Limits in the McCook and Lake Calumet Areas in Cook County, Illinois and the Granite City Area in Madison County, Illinois, by a vote of 7-0. (JTM)

By a vote of 7-0, the parties were directed to file, by September 9, 1991, a status report informing the Board of the desired disposition of the proceedings in #87-132, City of Chicago. (RCF)

An Order, to correctly caption the case as an Air Permit Appeal rather than an Underground Storage Tank Fund Reimbursement Determination, was adopted in #91-132, Quantum Chemical, by a vote of 7-0. (BF)

An Order was adopted pursuant to a McHenry County objection in #91-104, Village of Fox River Grove, by a vote of 5-2. Messrs. J. Dumelle and B. Forcade dissented. (JA)

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 7-0: R91-19, Potentially Infectious Medical Waste (PIMW): Etiological Agents, the Board, on its own motion, opened this docket for the purpose of conducting preliminary steps to this rulemaking pending the Governor's signature of House Bill 2491, which amends various provisions of the Environmental Protection Act as they relate to potentially infectious medical wastes, Order by R.C. Flemal; R91-20, Potentially Infectious Medical Waste (PIMW): Treatment, Storage, and Transfer Facilities, the Board, on its own motion, opened this docket for the purpose of conducting this rulemaking pending the Governor's signature of House Bill 2491, and considering the time deadline and the fact that no proposal for rulemaking exist, the Board ordered inquiry hearings to be set,

Order by R.C. Flemal; R91-21, Potentially Infectious Medical Waste (PIMW): Transportation, Packaging, and Labeling, the Board, on its own motion, opened this docket for the purpose of conducting this rulemaking pending the Governor's signature of House Bill 2491, and considering the time deadline and the fact that no proposal for rulemaking exist, the Board ordered inquiry hearings to be set, Order by R.C. Flemal; R91-23, Petition of Marathon Oil Company for Site-Specific Rule Change, additional information requested and Petitioner advised that if an amended proposal curing the noted deficiencies is not filed within 60 days this matter is subject to dismissal for inadequacy, Order by J.C. Marlin; R91-24, Exemptions from Definitions of VOM, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 218 and 219, Docket Reserved.
