MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING OCTOBER 10, 1991 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

Chairman Marlin called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. Thereafter, Board Member B. Forcade introduced his new attorney assistant, Diane O'Neil. All Board Members were present. As Mr. Meyer's arrival was delayed by approximately 10 minutes, the meeting commenced with case discussions.
