MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
April 29, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present .

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
78-50, North Shore Sanitary District; 80-224, Beker; 81-161, Quality Ready Mix; 81-176, Conley; 81-207, Bloomingdale, Mr. Goodman concurred; 82-8, Lombard Pines; 82-10, Orland Park; 82-11, Wenona.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #78-226, Modern Plating by a vote of 4-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented.

R80-6, WQS Amendments was dismissed since the amendments will be incorporated for hearing with R82-5. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Proposed Rule, First Notice was adopted in R81-11, Trihalomethanes, by a vote of 5-0.

Proposed amendments for hearing were adopted in R82-5, Effluent Standards Revisions, by a vote of 5-0.

Resolution and Order was adopted in R82-8,-9, Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources, by a vote of 5-0.

Motion to dismiss in #79-112, Modine was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for time to reply to a discovery motion in #81-48, Land and Lakes, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motions to dismiss in #81-175, Weich v. Van Drunen, were denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss a party in #82-16, Steel, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss a party in R79-8, Modine, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In R80-5, RACT II, motion for oral argument was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
