MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
May 27, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

The Board asked the Clerk to just reserve the Opinion and Order in #80-125, Welin, noting the typographical errors. It was determined that there was no need to vote again on the Opinion and Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-37, Cargill, by a vote of 4-1. Mr. Goodman dissented.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 81-185, Wathen v. Hogan, 82-24, DuPage; 82-25, Wildcat #2.

An Order was adopted in #82-12, Aurora, by a vote of 5-0.

A Proposed Order, First Notice and a Proposed Opinion were adopted in R80-5, RACT II, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Order was adopted in #80-126, Olin, on a motion for rehearing by a vote of 4-1. Mr. Goodman dissented. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #81-117, Olin, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #81-136, Willutzki, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motions to stay or continue in #81-175, Weich, were denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Request to be dropped in #81-182, Strata, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension in #82-14, Good Hope, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motions to withdraw in ## 81-168, Luria Bros., 82-30, Chrysler and 82-62, Southern Chemical, were granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Orders.

Motion to vacate in #82-55, Waste Management, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

A Final Order was adopted in #79-35, Chevy Chase, by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-107, Abingdon, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman abstained.

These cases were discussed and held to June 10 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 80-232,-233, Wastex; 81-143, Wheeler; 81-160, Chicago Hospital; 81-188, American Fly Ash; 81-196, Westport; 82-7, Wyoming; 82-27, Oak Brook; 82-35, Carlyle; 82-36, Mobil Oil.

The amended petition in #82-29, Lake County, was authorized for hearing since objections were filed.

A second amended petition was requested in #82-41, Algonquin. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

These regulatory proceedings were discussed and held to June 10 for possible action: R76-14, Forging Noise; R81-28, Public Water Supply Amendments.

An Order was adopted in R81-1, Procedural Rules Codification by a vote of 5-0.

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 5-0: ## 82-64, Salem, hearing authorized; 82-65, John Prior, hearing authorized; 82-66, West Suburban Association, additional information requested, Order by Mr. Goodman; 82-67, Growmark, hearing authorized.

Minutes of the regular Board meeting held May 13, 1982 were approved by a vote of 5-0.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to June 10, 1982 for possible consideration.
