MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
June 10, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

An Order was adopted in #81-143, Wheeler, which remanded the proposed stipulation back to the parties. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: #81-160, Chicago Hospital Council; 81-196, Westport; 82-7, Wyoming; 82-35, Carlyle; 82-36, Mobil Oil.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-27, Oak Brook, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson concurred and Mr. Goodman abstained.

An Order was adopted in R76-14, Forging Noise sending it to Second Notice. The vote was 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

An Order was adopted in #80-175, Unity Ventures, which ordered the matter to hearing. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to modify in #80-224, Beker, was granted by a vote of 4-1. Mrs. Anderson concurred, Mr. Anderson dissented and Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to join County of Cook in #82-16, Steel et al. v. Beucher et al., was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #82-32, Woodridge, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

The Board adopted an Order in #82-55, Waste Management, which established a briefing schedule, denied oral argument and ordered to hearing. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare the Orders.

These matters were discussed and held to July 1 for further discussion or possible decision: #80-232, -233, Wastex; 81-59, Carmi; 82-12, Aurora; R81-11, Trihalomethanes; R81-28, Public Water Supply Amendments.

Mr. Dumelle noted that the comment period ends on June 14 in R81-23, Ammonia Water Quality Standards and that he might request a special meeting to decide it on June 16 or 17.

A proposal by the Board, R81-12, Lead Ambient Air Quality Standards, was authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

These actions were taken on amended petitions: ## 81-163, John Deere, held for an Agency recommendation; 82-41, Algonquin, held for an Agency recommendation; 82-53, Meyercord, hearing authorized; 82-63, Citizens Utilities, held for an Agency recommendation.

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 5-0: ## 82-68, Trade Waste, hearing authorized, motion for stay denied, Order by Mr. Goodman; 82-69, Hanover Park v. County Board of DuPage et al. , hearing authorized, Order on procedure and record by Mrs. Anderson; 82-70,-71,-72, Caterpillar Tractor, hearings authorized; 82-73, Potomac, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson.

A provisional variance, #82-74, Borden Chemical, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Opinion and Order.

Mr. Anderson noted that final codified versions of these rules were still not available: R81-1, Procedural Rules; R81-3, Water Pollution Regulations; R81-5, Agricultural Related Pollution and R81-32, U.I.C. Rules.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered placed on an agenda for possible consideration on July 1, 1982.
