MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
July 21, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
##80-75, Springman, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 80-232,-233, Wastex,
Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Anderson concurred; 81-3, Goldstein Hog Farm;
82-20, Sobel; 82-57, Westtowns.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-1:
81-59, Carmi; 81-188, American Fly Ash. Mr. Goodman dissented in
both.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-145, Carrollton, by a vote
of 4-1. Mr. Dumelle dissented.

A Final Order was adopted on R76-14, Forging Noise, by a vote
of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

Proposed Rules, Second Notice was adopted in R81-11, Trihalomethanes,
by a vote of 5-0.

Proposed Rule, First Notice was adopted in R81-16, Non-attainment
Programs, Docket B, by a vote of 5-0.

A Final Order was adopted in R81-23, Ammonia Nitrogen, by a vote
of 5-0.

Motion for extension of time was granted in #78-233, Granite
City, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in #79-35, Chevy Chase, was denied by a vote
of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner dissented. Mrs. Anderson will
prepare an Order.

Motions in #80-38, Bacon's Farm, were held to September 2, 1982
for consideration. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an
Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #81-37, Cargill, was denied by a vote
of 3-2, Mr. Goodman and Mr. Anderson dissented. Mr. Dumelle will
prepare an Order.

Motion to strike in #81-144, Marathon Oil, was denied by a vote
of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to modify in #81-148, Oak Grove, was denied with leave to
file supplemental material by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will
prepare an Order.

Motion to consolidate in #81-200 et al., Caterpillar, was granted
by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #82-16, Steel, petition to intervene was granted and motion to vacate denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Petition for rehearing in #82-17, Round Lake, was denied and time for acceptance of the variance was extended by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to exclude additional evidence and to conclude hearing in #82-55, Waste Management was granted by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Anderson and Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in the matter of #82-69, Hanover Park, which addressed various pending motions. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson prepared the Order.

In #82-66, West Suburban, a second amended petition was requested by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.


The meeting was adjourned until 2:30 P.M.
