MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
October 5, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-135, Metro East Sanitary District, by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Goodman and Mr. Anderson dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-143, Wheeler, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 81-163, Deere; 82-1, Village of Ashland; 82-23, Trojan (Order only); 82-87, Union Oil.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-94, City of Assumption, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle Dissented.

In R80-5, RACT II, A Proposed Rule, Second Notice and a Proposed Opinion were adopted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner concurred.

A Final Order was adopted in R81-11; Trihalomethanes, by a vote of 5-0.

In ##75-80, -141, U.S. Steel, the Board determined that no action was needed on a petition to withdraw since the Hearing Officer has already ruled on the petition.

Motion for stay in #80-21, Interstate, was granted for 60 days by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-175, Unity, on a motion for reconsideration. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Respondent's motion to modify in #81-98, Wasteland, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order. Complainant's motion to clarify or modify was held for consideration on October 14.

Motion to dismiss in #81-134, Donovan was discussed, reassigned from Mr. Anderson to Mr. Dumelle and held for consideration on October 14.

An Order was adopted in #82-15, Hamman, addressing various motions filed. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to appear in #82-93, Georgia-Pacific, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #82-111, Modine, was denied by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motions to Stay in R82-14, RACT III, were denied by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Werner concurred. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #81-20, Metro East, continuance was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

The Board considered a request for evening hearing in #82-109, Granite City. It was the consensus of the Board that the Clerk contact the Hearing officer and request that the hearing be held in the evening.

These cases were discussed and held to October 14 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 81-171, Getty; 81-179, Nauvoo Milk Products; 81-187, Norris City Sanitary District; 82-65, John Prior; 82-68, Trade Waste.

#82-81, Yogi Bear's Park, was dismissed since the petitioner did not respond to a Board Order. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

R78-15, Rochelle and R81-24, Olin were discussed and held for consideration on October 14.

R80-20 and R81-31, Amendments to Chapter 7 and Chapter 9, were dismissed by a vote of 5-0.

Dockets were opened for R82-21, Waste Disposal and Transportation Permits and R82-22, Landfill Criteria by Board Orders. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Anderson will prepare Orders.

Orders were adopted in R82-23, New Source Performance Standards and R82-24, NESHAPS, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Orders.

In R81-16, Non-attainment, Rule 1101 was adopted on an emergency basis by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Atlantic Richfield et al., held for consideration on October 14; 82-115, General Motors, hearing authorized; 82-116, Downers Grove Bank, additional information requested, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 82-117, West Frankfort, additional information requested, expedited consideration granted, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 82-118, Illinois Dept. of Transportation, Boyle, Chairman authorized to sign, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 82-119, Waste Management v. Lake County Board, hearing authorized, Order by Mrs. Anderson, motion for clarification held to October 14 for consideration; 82-120, Peabody Coal, hearing authorized; 82-121, Growmark, hearing authorized.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on October 14, 1982.
