MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
November 12, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
81-76, Kraus v. MSD, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 82-18, Mobil Chemical; 82-29, Lake County Public Works.

In #81-11, Lake County Grading, the proposed stipulation was rejected pending receipt of additional information by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Werner will prepare an Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-13, Arcola, by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Goodman concurred, Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Anderson dissented.

A Proposed Order, First Notice and a Proposed Opinion were adopted in R81-24, Olin, by a vote of 5-0.

Motion for expedited consideration in #75-80,-141, U.S. Steel, was ordered held for consideration along with the case.

Motions to dismiss in ## 79-55 and 79-104, Interlake, were granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Orders.

An Order was adopted in #80-175, Unity Ventures, regarding discovery requests. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #81-177, A.S. Hansen, motion for postponement was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to appear in #82-108, Chrysler, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to expedite decision in #82-109, Granite City Steel, was ordered as taken with the case.

Motion to dismiss in #82-128, Bliss et al., was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time in #82-23, Trojan, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Pursuant to a telephone call by one of the attorneys involved in #79-231, Altamont, the Board decided to ask the Hearing Officer to continue the hearing set for November 18, 1982.

Site-specific petitions for noise filed by Amforge, Modern Drop Forge and Wyman-Gordon were ordered docketed under R82-31 as dockets A,B,C, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Minutes of Board meetings held October 5, 14, and 27, 1982 were approved by a vote of 5-0 as corrected.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on December 2, 1982.
