MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
July 8, 1976 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: #75-409, Uhler; 75-447, Bernardi (Interim Order); 76-36, Calumet Park; 76-40, Alex Chesney; 76-110, City of Lincoln; 76-116, Bird & Son; 76-89, Union Electric.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #75-262, SEMCO, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Young abstained.

An Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 4-1 in #76-51, World Color Press, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

R75-1, Procedural Rules Amendments were held to July 22, 1976 for discussion.

An Order was adopted in ##73-509,-510, Olin Corporation on a motion for modification and clarification by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Young abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to hold over motion for summary judgement was granted in ##74-475 and 75-35, General Motors by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion to reopen in #75-175, CPC was denied by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #75-284, Harrisburg Coal, motion for modification was denied by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Young abstained. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to modify in #75-393, National Metalwares was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion for oral argument in #76-2, Sanitary District of Decatur was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to dismiss in #76-107, Consolidated Freightways was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion to dismiss in #76-112, Flint Ink Co. was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

R75-4, Episodes, a motion to reconsider was postponed indefinitely.

In new case #76-157, Des Plaines et al v. MSD et al, all parties were present and a transcript of the Board's discussion of the case was taken. The Board voted 4-1 to dismiss the complaint, Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

New case #76-167, New Lenox v. Aurora Iron & Metal was held to July 22, 1976 for action.

Decatur Sanitary District, hearing authorized; 76-182, City of Oakland, held for an Agency recommendation; 76-183, Village of Ladd, additional information requested, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 76-184, People v. Waste Management, hearing authorized and amended complaint accepted, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 76-185, City of Decatur and Decatur Sanitary District, held for an Agency recommendation; 76-186, Ashland Chemical, hearing authorized; 76-187, City of Ottawa, held for an Agency recommendation; 76-188, Village of Bureau, dismissed, Order by Mr. Young.


A petition for amendments to the Noise Pollution Regulations was authorized for hearing and publication and given the #R76-14.

The Board held an administrative session with Ms. Wiley.

Matters on appeal in other courts was discussed by the Board.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to July 22, 1976.
