MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
March 17, 1977 Chicago, Illinois

Mr. James Young was not present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #76-100, Brighton Construction et al by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented and will file a dissenting opinion.

Request for oral argument in #73-30, Hall was denied by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motions to vacate were granted by a vote of 4-0 in #76-155, Chicago & Northwestern R.R. Mr. Young will prepare the Order.

An Order was adopted in #76-235, McGuire et al on various pending motions by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Young will prepare the Order.

A hearing was authorized in #76-274, Union Electric pursuant to an objection filed by the Illinois EPA. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

A motion to set date certain in #77-3, Schlemmer was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

A motion to dismiss in #77-32, Mt. Vernon was denied and a hearing was authorized by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #77-49, Illinois Central Gulf was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.
