MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
March 28, 1977 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##74-455, U.S. Tobacco; 75-125, Morton-Norwich; 76-60, Lincoln; 76-208, CPC, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 76-244, North Shore Sanitary District; 76-284, Farmington; 76-315, Livingston; 77-14, Caseyville; 76-257, DeSoto; 77-43, Village of St. Peter.

An Order was adopted in #75-472, Western Properties regarding a motion to dismiss, amended complaint and motion for continuance by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time to respond to a motion in #76-248, Ashland was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was entered in #76-276, Troy remanding back to the Hearing Officer by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion to strike in #76-311, Willing was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #76-316, South DuPage was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

An Order was adopted in #77-9, B.F. Goodrich on a motion for clarification by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file recommendation in #77-13, Commonwealth Edison was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in #77-33, Maple Leaf was denied by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare an Order.

Motion to strike in #77-37, Daubs was denied by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Zeitlin dissented. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #77-44, Interlake by a vote of 5-0 on a motion to dismiss. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Petition to intervene in #77-54, Armour-Dial was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #77-68, Lake Arlann was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #77-69, Kaufman was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #77-70, Minnesota was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Objections having been filed, hearings were authorized by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##77-78, Evergreen; 77-81 Casalino; 77-83 Waterman.

#76-79, City of Chicago was remanded back to the parties for submittal of a signed stipulation by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in R77-2, AQS, Temporary Emergency amendments closing the matter to further proceedings. The vote was 5-0 and Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

No additional information having been filed, these cases were dismissed by a vote of 5-0: ##76-306, Krenz Trucking, Order by Mr. Dumelle and 77-28, Rochelle, Order by Mr. Zeitlin will prepare an Order.

#77-6, Chillicothe was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

Moon et al, hearing mandatory; 77-90, Shell Oil, hearing authorized; 77-91, Willing, held for an Agency recommendation; 77-92, Union Electric, held to April 14 for consideration; 77-93, Ohio Power, held for an Agency recommendation.

#R77-6, WQS, Ammonia Nitrogen was authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 5-0.
