In R96-13, 15% ROP Plan: Clean-up Part II: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 218 and 219, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Expedited Correction Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (JTM)

In R96-16, Exemptions From the Definition of VOM, USEPA Amendments (February 7, 1996: Perchloroethylene), an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 6-1. Board Member J. Theodore Meyer dissented. **(GTG)**

In R97-11, Site Remediation Program (Brownfields) 35 Ill. Adm. Code 740, a Proposed Rule, First Notice, Opinion and Order was adopted y a vote of 7-0. (KMH)(GTG)(McF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AS 97-1, American River Transportation Company v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (GTG)

A motion for appearance Pro Hac Vice on behalf of the petitioner by Chester R. Babst II, Donald C. Bluedorn II, and Gregory D. Timmons in AS 97-6, Petitioner of Granite City Steel for an Adjusted Standard from 35 III. Adm. Code 302.212 and 302.213, Water Quality Standards Relating to Ammonia, will be handled when an amended petition is filed as requested by Board Order on January 23, 1997.

An Opinion and Order granting the joint motion requesting relief from the Illinois Environmental Protection Act's hearing requirement, and accepting the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement in the amount of \$4,000.00, was adopted in #96-130, People of the State of Illinois v. Parco Asbestos Removal Company, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. (McF)

An Opinion and Order granting the joint motion requesting relief from the Illinois Environmental Protection Act's hearing requirement, and accepting the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement in the amount of \$1,000.00, was adopted in #96-133, People of the State of Illinois v. Village of Tilton, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (JY)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #96-193, W.R. Grace Company-Connecticut v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. Board Member M. McFawn concurred. (JTM)

A Default Order finding that the respondent violated Section 21(o)(5) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, and assessing a \$500.00 penalty, was adopted in #AC 97-44, IEPA v. Tazewell Recycling and Disposal Facility, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

A Default Order finding that the respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), 21(p)(4), and 21(p)(6) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, and assessing a \$2,000.00 penalty, was adopted in #AC 97-46, County of LaSalle v. Ace Auto Salvage, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order granting the petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, was adopted in #91-75, Community Consolidated School District No. 15 v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (JY)

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to withdraw its permit appeal, was adopted in #96-95, AlliedSignal, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (McF)

An Order granting the parties' request for stay until April 7, 1997, was adopted in #96-147, People of the State of Illinois v. Illinois Cement Company, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (CAM)

An Order accepting the status report filed by the petitioner in response to a November 7, 1996 Board order, and directing the petitioner to file an additional status report on or before March 18, 1997, was adopted in #96-164, CGE Ford Heights, L.L.C. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

An Order granting the joint motion to change caption, was adopted in #96-201, People of the State of Illinois v. Coalville Road Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Coalville Road Landfill, f/k/a Streator Area Landfill #2, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Opinion and Order granting the petitioner's motion for leave to file its response to the Agency's motion to dismiss instanter, and granting the Agency's motion to dismiss the petitioner's petition for variance and closing the docket, was adopted in #97-58, W.R. Meadows, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (McF)

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to voluntarily dismiss, was adopted in #97-76, Regent Investment Corporation v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)

An Order accepting the complainant's motion for an extension of time up to and including March 4, 1997 to respond to respondent Amoco Oil Company's motion to dismiss, and accepting the joint stipulation correcting a named respondent, pursuant to Section 103.121(b) of the Board's rules (35 Ill. Adm. Code 103.121(b)), was adopted in #97-84, George Casanave v. Amoco Oil Company and Ray L. Pearson, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order determining that the complaint is neither duplications or frivolous, accepting the matter for hearing, and accepting the parties joint stipulation correcting a named respondent, pursuant to Section 103.121(b) of the Board's rules (35 Ill. Adm. Code 103.121(b)), was adopted in #97-84, Jerry Austman and Theresa Strahm v. Amoco Oil Company, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order determining that the complaint is neither duplicitous or frivolous, and accepting the matter for hearing, was adopted in #97-121, Matteson WHP Partnership v. James W. Martin and Eva D. Martin, individually and d/b/a Martin's of Matteson, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (McF)

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before March 24, 1997, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #97-124, Herb Treder (Site Classification Completion Report) v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before March 24, 1997, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #97-125, Herb Treder (Physical Soil Classification) v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

A mandatory hearing will be held in #97-127, People of the State of Illinois v. Pettibone Corporation.

An Order directing the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice of the parties motion to request relief from hearing requirement, was adopted in #97-128, People of the State of Illinois v. Belle-Aire Fragrances, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

This case was held for an Agency Recommendation: #97-129, Pinewood Mobile Home Park v. IEPA.

A mandatory hearing will be held in #97-130, People of the State of Illinois v. Big O, Inc..

An Order directing the petitioner to file an amended petition on or before March 24, 1997, and advising the petitioner that the filing of the amended petition will restart the Board's decision timeclock pursuant to Section 38(a) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, was adopted in #97-131, Central Illinois Public Service Company (Coffeen Power Station) v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (CAM)

A provisional variance was granted in #97-132, Clark Refining & Marketing, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to withdraw its petition for review, was adopted in #95-105, Saline County Landfill v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**


