MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 3, 1997 CHICAGO, ILLIOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Claire Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call, and all Board Members answered present.

Minutes of the March 20, 1997 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 7-0.

In R97-7, Wastewater Pretreatment Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 1996 through June 30, 1996), an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(JY)**

An Order accepting the matter for hearing, and granting in part, the Agency's motion for waiver of certain filing requirements, was adopted In R97-25, Conforming Amendments for the Great Lakes Initiative: 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 302.101, 302.105, 302.Subpart E, 303.443, and 304.222, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(GTG)(CAM)(JY)**

An Order accepting the Agency's status report in response to a January 9, 1997 Board order, and noting that the Agency's request for an extension of stay is moot since in response to a similar filing by the petitioner, the Board granted a stay in the matter until May 12, 1997, was adopted in #AS 94-5, Petition of Abbott Laboratories for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 218 Subpart R, by a vote of 7-0. **(JTM)**

An Order denying the Agency's motion to stay, and noting that if the Agency needs to briefly postpone the April 17, 1997 hearing for reasons other than those stated in the motion, that the Agency should file a motion requesting such an extension before the hearing officer, was adopted in #AS 97-5, Petition of the Louis Berkman Company, d/b/a The Swenson Spreader Company for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 215 Subpart F, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #96-110, Sara Scarpino and Margaret Scarpino v. Henry Pratt Company, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Opinion and Order accepting the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement in the amount of \$10,000.00, was adopted in #96-201, People of the State of Illinois v. Coalville Road Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Coalville Road Landfill, f/k/a Streator Area Landfill #2, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Opinion and Order accepting the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement in the amount of \$1,000.00, was adopted in #97-141, People of the State of Illinois v. Mark Meade Excavators, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

An Order accepting the matter for hearing, was adopted in #97-154, Monsanto Company (William G. Krummrich Plant) v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(RCF)**

An Order finding the complaint to be neither duplicitous or frivolous, and accepting the matter for hearing, was adopted in #97-158, Donald and Vern Bryant v. Doug Heil and Harrisburg Truss Company, by a vote of 7-0. **(JTM)**

An Order denying the petitioner's motion to incorporate the entire record of a prior proceeding into the instant proceeding as overly broad, incorporating by reference the prior Board opinions and orders from PCB 78-271, noting that the petitioner may upon separate written request incorporate relevant portions of the prior record by filing four copies of the material with the Clerk of the Board consistent with the Board's procedural rules at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.06, and deferring decision on the merits of the petition until the Agency files a recommendation with the Board and the petitioner, was adopted in #97-159, Central Illinois Public Service Company (Newton Station) v IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(RCF)**

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before May 20, 1997, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #97-167, Litchfield-Hillsboro Landfill v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

A mandatory hearing will be held in #97-168, People of the State of Illinois v. Old World Industries, Inc., and Specialty Sealant Tapes, Inc..

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before June 1, 1997, the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition, was adopted in #97-169, Maywood/Phillips 66 v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**



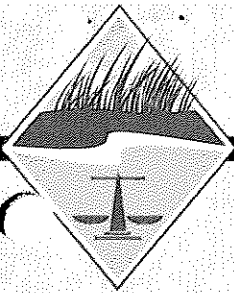
