MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING MAY 15, 1997 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed the members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call, and all Board Members answered present except J. Theodore Meyer who was absent.

In R97-15(A), Livestock Waste Regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 506, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 4-2. Messrs. R.C. Flemal and G. Tanner Girard dissented. (CAM)

In R97-17, Exemptions from the Definition of VOM, USEPA Amendments (July 1, 1996 through December 31, 1996; HFC 43-10mee and HCFC 225ca and cb), an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 6-0. (GTG)




