In 97-23, Wastewater Pretreatment Update, USEPA Regulations (July 1, 1996 through December 31, 1996), an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 5-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (JY)

In R98-1, Definition of VOM Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1 through June 30, 1997), a Proposed Rule, Dismissal Order, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. (GTG)
