MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING SEPTEMBER 4, 1997 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present.

Minutes of the August 7, 1997 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 6-0. Board Member J. Theodore Meyer abstained.

Minutes of the August 21, 1997 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 6-0. Chairman Claire A. Manning abstained.

In R90-1(B), Toxic Air Contaminants List (35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 232): Environmental Effects Consideration, a dismissal order closing the docket, was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (JY)

In R98-11, Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 501 through 504: Agricultural-Related Pollution (Management of Livestock Waste), a Request for Public Comments and/or Proposals order, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (CAM)

The Board, on its own motion, ordered the petitioner and the Environmental Protection Agency to return to hearing and to update the record in the matter, directing the petitioner and the Agency to clearly identify any exhibits or any other parts of the material entered into the record at the 1995 hearing and its relevance to the amended petition prior to proceeding to hearing, denying the Agency's request to deny the petitioner's motion to amend its requested relief, denying the Agency's request made in its post-hearing brief to deny the relief requested in the petitioner's amended petition for an adjusted standard, was adopted in #AS 94-20, Petition of the Galesburg Sanitary District, Galesburg, Illinois for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.105 (Ammonia Nitrogen), by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (RCF)

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to incorporate all materials previously attached to its petition for an adjusted standard filed on December 28, 1995, was adopted in #AS 96-6, In the Matter of: Petition of Amoco Oil Company for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 721.132, by a vote of 7-0. (McF)

An Order granting the petitioner's requested stay until November 10, 1997 to file an amended petition for an adjusted standard, was adopted in #AS 97-6, Petition of Granite City Steel for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.212 and 302.213, Water Quality Standards Relating to Ammonia, by a vote of 6-0. Board Members K.M. Hennessey abstained. (RCF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #96-151, Keith F. Boyer v. Felicia Harris, a/k/a Felecia Dawkins, and Chicagoland Mortgage Corporation, by a vote of 7-0. (McF)

An Opinion and Order granting the joint motion requesting relief from the hearing requirement, and accepting the stipulation and settlement agreement in the amount of \$10,000,00, was adopted in #97-80, People of the State of Illinois v. Alliant Techsystems, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. (JTM)

An Opinion and Order granting the joint motion requesting relief from the hearing requirement, and accepting the stipulation and settlement agreement in the amount of \$8,700,00, was adopted in #97-127, People of the State of Illinois v. Pettibone Corporation, by a vote of 7-0. (JTM)

An Opinion and Order granting the joint motion requesting relief from the hearing requirement, and accepting the stipulation and settlement agreement in the amount of \$10,000.00, was adopted in #97-196, People of the State of Illinois v. Di Mucci Development Corporation of Round Lake, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (GTG)

An Opinion and Order denying the petition for variance and closing the docket, was adopted in #97-205, Illinois Landfill, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (GTG)

A Default Order finding that the respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(3) of the Environmental Protection Act, and assessing a \$1,000.00 penalty, was adopted in #AC 98-3, County of Will v. Sherry Fetcho, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

Because a petition for review was filed by the respondent, this administrative citation will be set for hearing: #AC 98-4, County of Sangamon v. ESG Watts, Inc..

An Order directing the parties to file briefs on the bankruptcy issues on or before October 3, 1997, and reply briefs on or before October 17, 1997, was adopted in #96-265, Edward M. Pearl v. Bicoastal Corporation, Singer Corporation, and Eaton Corporation, by a vote of 7-0. (JY)

An Order denying the Agency's motion for summary judgment, and noting that the matter shall proceed to hearing, was adopted in #97-210, ESG Watts, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (JY)

An Order accepting the matter for hearing, was adopted in #97-226, Riverview FS v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Order dismissing the proceedings and closing the docket, was adopted in #97-235, Laidlaw Waste Systems, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order accepting the matter for hearing, was adopted in #98-32, Owens Oil Company v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order extending the 35-day appeal period, reserving the docket for any appeal which may be filed by the petitioner, noting that in the event that the petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before October 15, 1997, the Board will dismiss the docket, and advising the petitioner that a \$75.00 filing fee will be required at such time as the petitioner files a petition for review, was adopted in #98-33, East Saint Louis Housing Authority v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**


All other matters not disposed of as listed were held.


