MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING

OCTOBER 16, 1997 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting, and then introduced and welcomed new employee Jack Burds, who will serve as a hearing officer for the Board. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present.

Minutes of the October 2, 1997 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 7-0.

In R97-25, Conforming Amendments for the Great Lakes Initiative: 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 302.101, 302.105, 302.SubpartE, 303.443, and 304.222, a Proposed Rule, Second Notice, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(GTG)(CAM)(JY)**

In R98-8, Clean Fuel Fleet Program: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 241, a Proposed Rule, Second Notice, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 7-0. **(JY)**

An Order finding that the petition meets the minimum requirements of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.160(a), accepting the matter for hearing, granting the petitioner's motion for expedited hearings, and directing the assigned hearing officer to consult with counsel for the Environmental Protection Agency to set hearings as required pursuant to Title VII of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/26 *et seq.*) at the earliest available mutually agreeable dates, was adopted in R98-13, Amendments to General Permitting Provisions to Require Perpetual Permits for Certain Sources: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 201, by a vote of 7-0. **(McF)**

The Agency's motion for an extension of time to file its response to the adjusted standard petition in #AS 98-2, Petition of City of Salem for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 814.Subpart D, was referred to the hearing officer for disposition.

An Opinion and Order granting the joint motion requesting relief from the hearing requirement, and accepting the stipulation and settlement agreement in the amount of \$7,500.00, was adopted in #94-83, People of the State of Illinois v. George Ribble, by a vote of 7-0. **(McF)**

An Order denying the motion for sanctions and the motion to strike the appearance, granting the motion to strike the objection to the motion for sanctions and the motion to clarify the caption, and to ensure that discovery proceeds in a timely manner, ordering respondent Lloyd Wiemann to file its responses to respondent Texaco Refining and Marketing's discovery requests on or before October 31, 1997, and noting that if respondent Wiemann fails to comply with this timeframe, the Board will, on its own motion, dismiss the cross-claim against cross-respondent Texaco Refining and Marketing and cross-respondents Eugene and Cheryl Halbrooks, was adopted in #93-191, People of the State of Illinois v. Lloyd Wiemann d/b/a Wiemann Ice and Fuel, Texaco Refining and Marketing, Inc., and Eugene and Cheryl Halbrooks, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to withdraw and closing the docket, was adopted in #95-166, Henri Studio, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

An Order granting the respondents' motion to dismiss without prejudice, and noting that because the motion to dismiss was granted, that the Board does not need to rule on the complainant's motion to withdraw, was adopted in #97-38, People of the State of Illinois v. Amsted Industries, Inc. d/b/a Griffin Wheel Company, L.E. Swiderski d/b/a Griffin Wheel Company and Horsehead Resource Development Company, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. Board Members M. McFawn and J. Theodore Meyer concurred. **(CAM)**

Office of the State Fire Marshal, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Order denying the complainant's motion for a default judgment to be entered against the respondent because complainant has been unable to effectuate service of the complaint upon the respondent, and noting that if the complainant cannot effectuate service on the respondent by the

methods outlined in Section 103.123(a) of the Board's procedural rules, complainant may move to serve the respondent by publication, was adopted in #97-234, Antonio D.H. Nam v. Kikon Suh, by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**



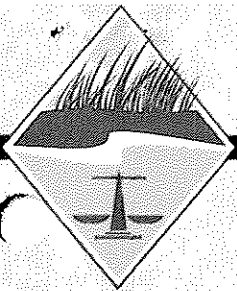

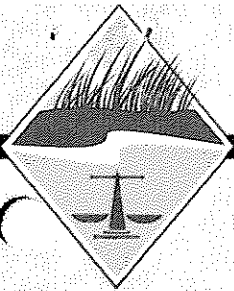
