MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 6, 1997 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call, and all Board Members answered present.




