

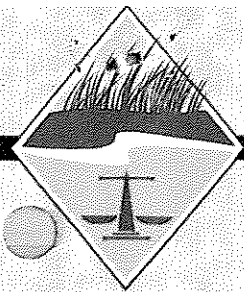
ADJOURNMENT

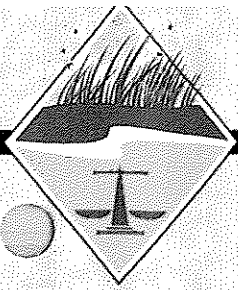
