

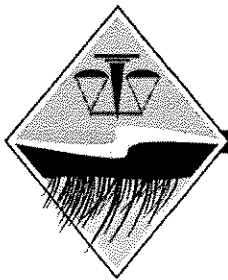
ADJOURNMENT

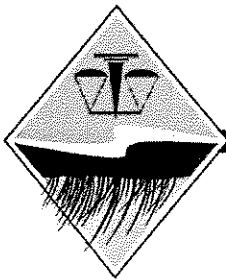

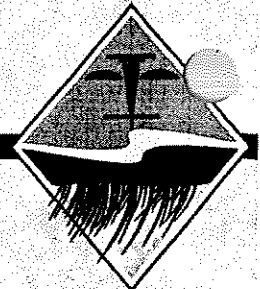
