MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 19, 1987 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

A.M. SESSION

All Board Members were present. As Mr. Meyer's arrival was delayed by approximately 30 minutes, the meeting commenced with case discussions.

An Opinion and Order were adopted in #86-197, Wayne County Board, by a vote of 4-2. Messrs. Dumelle and Meyer dissented. (BF)

An Order was adopted in #87-4, Duo-Fast Corporation, by a vote of 6-0. (BF)

An Interim Order was adopted in R77-4, Airport Noise, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Meyer voted present. (JM)

An Interim Order was adopted in R84-17 (Dockets A, B, and C),

Chapter 7 and 9 Update, by a vote of 6-0. (JA)

Motion to seek correction of January 8, 1987 Board Order was granted and paragraph 1 of the January 8, 1987 Order was modified in #85-227, Van Leer Containers, by a vote of 6-0. (JD)

An Order affording Complainants until March 13, 1987 to file a response showing cause as to why the complaint should not be dismissed in #86-44, Continental Grain, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. (RF)

Complainant's motion to supplement the record was granted in #86-74, E.J. Brach and Sons, by a vote of 6-0. (JD)

Motion to include transcript of Board meeting as part of record in #86-159, Joliet Sand and Gravel, was denied by a vote of 6-0. (JA)

An Order granting the Agency until February 27 to respond to Petitioner's motion for Stay in #87-7, Pearson Industries, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. (JA) (Thereafter the meeting was adjourned)

By a vote of 6-0 amended petition #86-225, City of Geneva, was held for an Agency Recommendation.

By a vote of 6-0 new case #87-16, City of Lockport, was held for an Agency Recommendation.

Minutes of the February 5, 1987 Board Meeting were approved by a

vote of 6-0.

All other matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to March 5, 1987 for possible consideration.
