Good afternoon Mr. Laurenzana. I understand that Mr. Fox has replied to your previous emails for status, I have nothing new to add. As the Board does not have investigators and functions more on the line of an environmental court, I would suggest a direct request to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency if you are seeking their review of the facility. To clarify, you can refile either of the two formal actions you have previously filed: the permit appeal or the formal complaint. We will docket them in as new cases and assign new docket numbers. Please remember you will have to follow the Environmental Protection Act and the Board's regulations to proceed with adjudicating either matter. We cannot give you legal assistance with these matters. I have attached the final orders in these matters which explain the procedural issues with your previous filings.
