ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie):

On January 23, 2025, at the parties' request, the Board extended until April 15, 2025, the time period for The Breaking Point, Inc. (The Breaking Point) to appeal a December 9, 2024 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns The Breaking Point's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 1855 West Willow Road in Northfield, Cook County. The Agency partially denied The Breaking Point's request for reimbursement of \$18,366.93 from the UST Fund covering the period of June 5, 2023, to September 30, 2024. Because The Breaking Point failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
