RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- 1. On March 15, 2024, the Illinois EPA received a request from Brad Kestner (Log number TC-151250) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204 (Exhibit A).
- 2. On March 5, 2025, Illinois EPA Bureau of Water confirmed the facility's address with Brad Kestner's agricultural engineer that submitted the application on behalf of Brad Kestner (Exhibit A).
- 3. On June 9, 2025, Illinois EPA Division of Legal Counsel notified Brad Kestner's agricultural engineer that the facility address and legal description provided in the application did not align with the Parcel Identification Number according to the Adams County Property Tax Inquiry database (Exhibit B).
- 4. On June 12, 2025, a revised Page 1 of the application was submitted with the correct facility address and legal description (Exhibit B).
- 5. The facility's address is:

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the

NW ¼ of Section 4, T2S, R5W of the 4th P.M. in Adams County, at the above street address and consist of the following livestock waste management structures:

One (1) bedpack barn 280 ft. (length) x 60 ft. (width) consisting of:

- one (1) concrete bedpack area measuring 204 ft. (length) x 46 ft. 2 in. (width) with 4 ft. (height) walls and the portion of the roof covering this area;
- one (1) manure stack area measuring 74 ft. (length) x 46 ft. 2 in. (width) x 6 ft. (height) and the portion of the roof covering this area;
- one (1) concrete manure scrape alley measuring 280 ft. (length) x 12 ft. (width) used for the transfer of manure and the portion of roof covering this area;
- one (1) 280 ft. (length) x 18 in. (width) x 6 in. (height) concrete curb used to contain waste and keep stormwater from entering; and
- two (2) 6 in. (height) x 12 ft. (length) reinforced roll curbs to help contain waste within the building and prevent surface water entrance.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application.

6. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2022), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

- 4. In order to receive preferential tax treatment pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2022), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20 (2022) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
- 5. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
- 6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution

control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board. (Exhibit C)

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.




Brad Kestner - Description of solid Waste storage Structure

The proposed bedpack waste storage barn consists of bedpack waste storage and manure stack waste storage all in one building. The overall building dimensions are 280' x 60' with 4' and 6' walls (see attached plan view and cross section for details).


The building is laid out with a 204' x 46' - 2" concrete bedpack area with 4' walls. This area serves as bedpack housing for the cattle as well as bedpack manure storage. On the west of the building is a 74' x 46'-2" x 6' manure stack which is used only for manure storage. All storages are open to the front with a 12' wide scrape alley and heavy use area. This is used to transfer (scrape) manure from the bedpack to the manure stack area. Walls are all 8" thick reinforced concrete and the floors are 5" thick reinforced concrete. 36" wide x 12" thick reinforced footings are located under each wall. In the front of the building, there are 14"diameter pillars on 36" diameter X 12" thick reinforced footings for roof support. Along the front of the building is a 280' x 18" x 6" reinforced concrete curb that is used to contain waste and keep stormwater from entering the building. Along the ends of each scrape ally are 6" x 12' reinforced roll curbs which also help contain waste inside the building and prevent surface water entrance.



The application provides a facility address of 1153 N 2753 Lane, Clayton, IL 62324, with a Parcel Identification Number of 110004200000. I know you previously confirmed with the Bureau of Water that the provided facility address is correct. However, according to the Adams County Tax Assessor's parcel search, that PIN number (11-0-0042-000-00) is associated with a different address: 2731 N. 1153rd Lane (first attachment). The legal description associated with this PIN also doesn't appear to match the legal description provided in the application. I don't see any of the PINS under Mr. Kestner's name associated with the 1153 N 2753 Lane address (second attachment).

Please review this information and let me know if you can account for or otherwise explain this apparent discrepancy. This records check would likely be addressed by the IL Department of Revenue following a Pollution Control Board, but I provide an initial review as courtesy before we go further with the time and resources of obtaining an Order.
