ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M.D. Mankowski):

On July 1, 2025, the parties timely filed a joint request to extend the 35-day period within which BP Products North America Inc./Riverfront Property (BP) may appeal a May 21, 2025, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency modified the revised corrective action plan at the BP light oils dock areas in Wood River, Madison County.

The Board extends the appeal period until Monday, October 6, 2025, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If BP fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
