
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On July 17, 2025, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference. The complainant complained that respondent has yet to complete his intake process for the Conflict Resolution program. Respondent's attorney stated that he will follow up with Mr. Eagan on that issue. Over objection, respondent given until July 28, 2025, to file his response to complainant's amended motion for summary judgement. No further extensions will be entertained. Complainant was informed that any motions to compel discovery will not be ruled on until the motion for summary judgement is decided

Complainant reported that, like last conference call, the dog and Mr. Eagan is rarely, if ever seen or heard. Complainant stated "it is a different issue now because she doesn't know where the dog is... most of the time the dog is hidden and so is Mr. Eagan." Complainant also stated that her video equipment cannot pick up the dog's noise from inside Mr. Eagan's house.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on September 11, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant by calling the number below, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


