# AMENDED RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On December 2, 2024, the Illinois EPA received a request from Clint Kinsey (Log number TC-151974, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204. On July 11, 2025, the Recommendation of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency was filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board. On July 23, 2025, the applicant submitted an updated drawing and narrative, correcting the dimensions identified in the December 2, 2024 application.

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the SW ¼ of Section 21, T14N, R2W in Mercer County, at the above street address and consist of the following livestock waste management structures:

One (1) concrete manure pit measuring 252 ft. (length) x 48 ft. (width) x 8 ft. (depth) and concrete slatted flooring over the manure pit. The manure deep pit has ten (10) pumpout pits measuring 5 ft. (length) x 5 ft. (width) x 8 ft. (depth) to allow manure removal from the pit.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application.

Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2022), and Section 3. 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution

control facilities" as:

In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2022), 4.

pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20

(2022) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).

5. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation

on the application with the Board, 35 III Adm. Code 125.204(a).

Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois 6.
