INITIAL COMMENTS OF ENVIRONMENTAL LAW & POLICY CENTER

Environmental Law & Policy Center (ELPC) appreciates the opportunity to engage in this docket and respectfully submits these initial comments pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.628(c) and 101.110(a). ELPC is the Midwest's leading environmental legal advocacy organization, which combines effective public interest litigation with strategic policy advocacy, sound science and economic analysis. ELPC concurs with the Illinois Attorney General that "environmental justice is a crucial consideration in every environmental law decision and is vitally important for protecting the constitutional right to a healthful environment for all citizens of Illinois." ELPC also concurs with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency that "[e]nvironmental justice concepts are embedded in a variety of State and federal laws, so it is appropriate for the Board to formally consider their application in its proceedings." It is more important than ever before that the State of Illinois, and its various levels of government, take necessary steps to provide a healthful environment for communities that have been, and remain, overburdened by pollution and environmental harms, which negatively impact human health and welfare.

ELPC further supports Earthjustice's and Sierra Club's requests that the Board keep this docket open to explore mechanisms by which the Board may incorporate environmental justice into its rules. Like Earthjustice and Sierra Club, ELPC also would welcome the opportunity to consider any guidance that the Board may issue to participants in this docket, including whether there are particular rules, or types of rules, into which the Board plans to build environmental justice considerations, and whether there are particular types of standards that the Board believes will be helpful to it in considering environmental justice. ELPC would welcome the opportunity to provide input or otherwise assist the Board in its efforts under this docket, and appreciate all guidance the Board can provide to help facilitate ELPC's and others' participation and engagement in those efforts.
