HEARING OFFICER LEONI: Okay. It's 10:00, so let's begin. Good morning, and welcome to this Illinois Pollution Control Board hearing, my name is Carlie Leoni, and I am the hearing officer for this rulemaking proceeding entitled Potentially Infectious Medical Waste, PIMW, Proposed Amendment of 35 Illinois Administrative Code 1422, Appendix A, Table B, Indicator Microorganisms. The Board docket number for this rulemaking is R25-24.

Also present today in Chicago from the Board are Board Member Jennifer Van Wie, the Board's technical unit Chief Environmental Scientist Anand Rao, and Environmental Scientist Essence Brown, and Board Senior Attorney Tim Fox. Board staff in Springfield via video are Board Member Angela Tin, Board Member Michael Mankowski, and Attorney Advisor Anupama Paruchuri. Participants of the rulemaking in Springfield via video are Alec Messina for the rule proponent, BioSAFE Engineering, Daniel Nelson for rule proponent BioSAFE engineering, Trevor Dell'Aquila for the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency or IEPA. And our witness today in Springfield is Joshua Rhoades for IEPA.

This hearing is governed by the Board's

procedural rules. All information that is relevant in that is not repetitious or privileged will be admitted into the record. Please bear in mind that any questions posed today by the Board and its staff are intended solely to help develop a clear and complete record for the Board's decision and do not reflect any decision on the proposal, testimony, or other questions. For the sake of our court reporter, especially in Springfield, please speak clearly and avoid speaking at the same time as another person so that we can help produce a clear transcript.

For background on this proceeding, on March 20, 2025, BioSAFE filed a rulemaking that proposed the Board amend Part 1422 of its potentially infectious medical waste rules BioSAFE requests that the Board add an indicator microorganism Bacillus atrophaeus to Part 1422 to be used for validation of low-pressure steam-based treatment systems for potentially infectious medical waste.

On April 3, 2025, the Board accepted the proposal and directed the hearing officer to proceed to hearing. The first hearing was held in Springfield on June 26, 2025, and focused on BioSAFE's proposal and its witnesses. Today we hold the second

Page 6 hearing. This hearing will be focused on the 1 participants' witness and their testimony. At the end 2 of the hearing today, I will go off the record to 3 discuss with everyone the schedule for post-hearing 4 5 comments. 6 Notice for this hearing was posted in 7 the State Journal-Register and the Chicago Sun-Times. 8 This publication occurred in the State Journal-Register 9 on May 18th and in the Chicago Sun-Times on May 19, 10 2025. 11 On May 15, 2025, the Board requested, 12 pursuant to Section 27(b) of the Environmental 13 Protection Act, that the Department of Commerce and 14 Economic Opportunity conduct a study on the economic 15 impact of the proposed rule amendment. The letter 16 requested that DCEO provide their response by July 14, 17 2025. As of today, DCEO has not responded to the 18 request. 19 The IEPA filed the written testimony of one witness on July 31st. BioSAFE filed written 20 21 questions on August 13th. And the Board filed written questions on August 18th. The IEPA filed written 22 23 answers on August 20th. 24 I just have one note on IEPA's answers

which were filed with the Board yesterday afternoon. I'm going to propose to enter these into there as an exhibit as if read today, but if anyone objects to that, please raise your objection and state your reason at that time. Please also keep in mind that there will be time to review IEPA's responses and prepare additional follow-up comments by the post-hearing comment deadline if needed.

As to the order of today's proceedings today, IEPA will put forth its witness to answer these and any follow-up questions the participants might have regarding their testimony and answers. We have only one witness scheduled today, Joshua Rhoades, and we will begin with him. The court reporter will swear in all witnesses when they begin.
