ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On March 26, 1996 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and Downtown Oil (Downtown) filed a notice of extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act (Act), relating to a February 27, 1996 Agency final determination.

By order of April 4, 1996 the Board reserved docket PCB 96-204 for any petition which might be filed by Downtown. The order stated, "In the event that Downtown fails to file an appeal on or before May 27, 1996 (the 90th day after February 27, 1996), the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary."

No petition has been filed. This matter is dismissed and the docket is closed as unnecessary.
