<u>PCB 26-48</u>	<u>Village of Frankfort v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Time-Limited WQS) – The Board acknowledged the Village’s filing of petition for a time-limited water quality standard but made no determination on the petition’s informational sufficiency or its merits.	5-0 roll call vote
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ADJUDICATORY CASES

<u>PCB 24-81</u>	<u>Marine Bank Springfield Trust #53-0051 v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board granted Marine Bank’s request to authorize payment of legal fees and directed IEPA to reimburse Marine Bank \$12,061 in legal fees from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-39</u>	<u>Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. (CID Recycling & Disposal Facility) v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Land, RCRA – Permit Appeal) – The Board accepted Waste Management’s petition for hearing on IEPA’s permit determination concerning hazardous waste management units in Cook County. The Board also reserved ruling on Waste Management’s motion for stay.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-40</u>	<u>Singh Inc. of Illinois v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board accepted an environmental consultant’s letter as a timely filed petition for review on behalf of Singh. The Board then directed Singh to file an amended petition addressing noted deficiencies and serve it on IEPA by April 20, 2026. The Board also reserved ruling on IEPA’s motion to dismiss.	5-0 roll call vote


