
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M.D. Mankowski):

On April 23, 2026, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Aqua Illinois, Inc. in Nordic Woods (Aqua Illinois) may appeal a March 26, 2026, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency issued a Special Exemption Permit that requires Aqua Illinois to submit monthly operating reports for its Nordic Woods public water supply facility located in Ogle County.

The Board extends the appeal period until July 29, 2026, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Aqua Illinois fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
