#### ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against County Line Swine for violating State pollution control rules. On April 28, 2026, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person who would like to comment on, or demand a public hearing on, the stipulation and proposal for settlement may do so by filing a written comment or hearing demand with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 30 days after the publication of this notice. The written comment or hearing demand must refer: People of the State of Illinois v. County Line Swine, Inc., PCB 26-57, and must be filed with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Board, 60 East Van Buren, Suite 630, Chicago, Illinois 60605.
