



**COMPLAINANTS’ UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AN APPEAL OF THE HEARING OFFICER’S RULINGS**

Complainants Sierra Club, Environmental Law & Policy Center (“ELPC”), Prairie Rivers Network, and National Association for Advancement of Colored People (“NAACP”) by their undersigned counsel, hereby request that the Hearing Officer enter an order granting Complainants’ motion to extend the time to file their appeal of the Hearing Officer’s rulings at the May 5, 2026 hearing.

In support of their Motion, Complainants state as follows:

1. On May 5, 2026, the first day of remedy hearings was held in this matter.
2. At that hearing, counsel for Respondent objected to certain evidence (Table 1 to Mark Hutson’s January 5, 2025 Report) and testimony relating to arsenic that Complainants offered. May 5, 2026 Hr’g Tr. 11:8-12:5; 97:24-98:4; 104:12-15; 131:15-132:3.
3. Complainants responded to Respondent’s objections on both the offered evidence and arsenic-related testimony and, multiple times in the hearing, the Parties engaged in lengthy on-the-record disagreements that are documented in the hearing transcript. May 5, 2026 Hr’g Tr.

11:1-12:21; 97:24-99:18; 104:12-107:6; 128:21-131:3; 131:15-136:12.

4. Due to the extent of these arguments, it was not feasible for Complainants to appeal the Hearing Officer's rulings without consulting the specific portions of the hearing transcript.


5. The hearing transcript was not posted in the docket for this matter until June 2, 2026.

6. Complainants extension request is limited to June 16, 2026, two weeks from when the transcript was posted on the PCB's electronic docket.

7. Counsel for Respondent communicated to counsel for Complainants that they do not object to this extension.

WHEREFORE, Complainants respectfully request an extension of time to respond to Respondent's Motion to Stay Proceedings until June 16, 2026.
