- 4 direction of the Illinois Pollution Control Board,
- 5 I now call Docket 97-111. This is the People of
- 6 the State of Illinois versus John Prior and
- 7 Industrial Salvage, Inc.
- 8 Let the record reflect that there are no
- 9 appearances at today's hearing, and there are no
- 10 members of the public present at today's hearing.
- 11 Also let the record reflect that by the Hearing
- 12 Officer's watch it is about seven or eight after

- Notice was sent to all parties, including
- 15 the Attorney General's office, on behalf of the
