On February 15, 2001, respondent Panhandle Eastern Pipeline Company (Panhandle) filed a motion requesting additional oral argument. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency filed a response on February 23, 2001. Panhandle's motion requests additional oral argument to supplement close to 1500 pages of the transcript for the hearing held in this matter, and over 280 pages of the parties' briefs.
